1                   An act to Require all Voters to Show Identification Information Before Voting

3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will require all voters to show identification information before voting in a local, state or  
6 national election. Information for identification will include the individual's name and a photo (driver's license  
7 or passport). Right now, Kentucky has no photo identification requirement and election officers confirm the  
8 identity of each voter by personal acquaintance or by a document that doesn't require a photo. This will help  
9 prevent voting fraud by confirming the identity of all voters.

11 Section 2: When a person reports to the voting precinct to vote, they must show photo identification with  
12 their name in order to vote. Voting officials will allow individuals who show identification to sign in and vote.  
13 Voters who fail to show photo ID are given a provisional ballot and must eventually show photo ID in order  
14 to get that provisional ballot counted.

15  
16 Section 3: For individuals who do not have photo identification with name at the time of voting will have a  
17 few days to produce the photo identification for their provisional ballot to be counted. If they fail to produce  
18 photo identification, their provisional ballot will not be counted. No funding will be needed, as all voting  
19 booth officials are volunteers.

20  
21 Section 4: This bill will take effect on February 1, 2014.
