1 An act to enforce motorcyclists to wear reflective jackets.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: All motorcyclists and their passengers will be required to wear a reflective jacket /vest while
6 riding the motorcycle.

7
8 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by law enforcement at no additional cost.

9
10 Section 3: This new bill will need to be advertised which will be paid for by the state.

11
12 Section 4: The reflective jackets & vests will cost between \$3.00-\$5.00 for each motorcyclist and/or
13 passenger to purchase.

14
15 Section 5: The reflective jackets & vests will only be one solid color with a reflective strip on the side and
16 belt area.

17
18 Section 6: Fines for not wearing a reflective jacket or vest will begin at \$100 and increase \$50 for each
19 consecutive offense.

20
21 Section 7: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2014.
