An act to prevent surgeons from drinking before their shift.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Many doctors "unwind" from a long, hard day of work by drinking. 5 out of every 25 drunk doctors are still needed in the hospital for the rest of the day.
