4 5 6 7	Section 1: For the safety of all motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists, all bicyclists (over 18) will be required to follow the rules of the road and acquire a bicycle license.
, 8 9 10	Section 2: In KY, 49% of bike accidents are the bicyclist's fault. This bill will help ensure fewer accidents, therefore keeping KY citizens safer.
11 12	Section 3: This will help our community by reducing tax payers' money for taxes, due to less bike accidents. Therefore, less emergency services will be needed.
13 14 15	Section 4: This bill will go into effect on 1/1/15
16 17 18	Section 5: Licenses can be acquired for \$20.00 after passing a written test at your local DMV. Licenses will need to be renewed every 5 years.
