1 An act to eliminate smoking in all enclosed workplaces statewide.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will prohibit smoking and the use of any other tobacco products in any enclosed
6 workplaces. It will punish those who do not comply with this bill with fines.

7
8 Section 2: The first offence will result in a warning to the business and the smoker. The second offence will
9 result in a \$500 fine to the business. If this fine goes unpaid, or if there is another offence, it will result in an
10 additional charge of \$2500.

12 Section 3: This bill will require all workplaces to post no smoking signs in both English and Spanish, and to
13 have a designated smoking area at least 25 feet from all entrances and exits.

15 Section 4: This bill will be enforced by employers and police in the entirety of the Commonwealth.

16
17 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2014.
