An act to eliminate smoking in all enclosed workplaces statewide.
Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
Section 1: This bill will prohibit smoking and the use of any other tobacco products in any enclosed
workplaces. It will punish those who do not comply with this bill with fines.
Section 2: The first offence will result in a warning to the business and the smoker. The second offence will
result in a \$500 fine to the business. If this fine goes unpaid, or if there is another offence, it will result in an
additional charge of \$2500.
Section 3: This bill will require all workplaces to post no smoking signs in both English and Spanish, and to
have a designated smoking area at least 25 feet from all entrances and exits.
Section 4: This bill will be enforced by employers and police in the entirety of the Commonwealth.
Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2014.
