1 An act to ban the prescription of Hydrocodone to individuals 18 and younger.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Hydrocodone is a Schedule II category of drug considered to have a strong potential for abuse or
6 addiction. Common side effects for hydrocodone usage includes: depression, inducing of a relaxed easy
7 state, not feeling well, and confusion.

8
9 Section 2: This bill will cost 0\$ to implement.

10
11 Section 3: Physician and Pharmacist prescribing or dispensing a controlled substance must comply with the
12 prescribing and dispensing regulations.

13
14 Section 4: The Office of Drug Control Policy will work with Kentucky State Police and sheriffs' offices to
15 enforce that Hydrocodone is not prescribed to this age group.

16
17 Section 4: Consequences for non-compliance will be as follows:

18 First Offense: \$500

19 Second Offense: \$1,000

20 Third Offense: Doctor or pharmacist license will be suspended.

21
22 Section 5: This bill will go into effect January 1st, 2014.
