1 An act to require a Federal Firearm License to manufacture a 3D Printed Firearm or to produce firearm parts.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to motivate Kentucky students to preform on the KPREP State Test.  
6 Many students in Kentucky do not take the state test into account and therefore do not often preform to  
7 the best of their ability. By implementing this bill, students will perform at a higher rate and in turn, be  
8 accountable for the permanence on the KPREP test.

10 Section 2: Currently in Kentucky, students are not held accountable for their performance on the state test.  
11 This bill will require that students perform at an APPRENTICE level of 35% on the KPREP test in order to be  
12 promoted to the next grade level. This means that students who do not perform at an Apprentice level will  
13 be retained at their current grade level for one year, or unless they are 16 years of age. At age 16, students  
14 may choose to attend summer school classes or attend an alternative program such as a technical or  
15 vocational school program.

17 Section 3: Once this bill is enacted, all students attending the Kentucky Public School system will be required  
18 to acheive an Apprentice on the KPREP Exam.

20 Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Education will be responsible for implementing this program.

21

22 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on September 2015.
