- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill would legalize staff members carry concealed weapons on school grounds.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: Every School in Kentucky must have one teacher per 100 students who has a concealed carry
- 8 license.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: Considering that this bill is mandatory that a certain amount of teachers have a concealed carry
- 11 license there are penalties is not enforced.
- 12
- 13 First Offense: The school would owe the state 100.00
- 14 Second Offense: 300.00
- 15 Third Offense: 500.00
- 16
- 17 Section 4: This Bill will not cost the staff member any money. The school district will be responsible for the
- 18 staff members guns, ammunition, and license.

- 20 Section 5: This Bill will go in effect on May 1st 2014
