- 1 An act to require every school district in the state of Kentucky to randomly drug test 10% of their student
2 athlete population

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
- 6 Section 1: This bill will be funded by raised school taxation of 1% and the standardized drug test will be a
7 urine test which is approximately \$20 per test.
8
- 9 Section 2: School districts that do not comply will lose their athletic funding for the following fiscal school
10 year that runs from July 1- June 1.

- 12 Section 3: This bill will go into effect the next fiscal school year (July 1).

- 14 Section 4: The drug tests must be administered evenly based on the number of athletes on each team and
15 each school district must keep a copy of the results for state review if requested.
