1 An act to grant KEES (Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship) money to students based on their
2 percentage of attendance throughout the school year.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: Currently in Kentucky, KEES Money is earned based on GPA, ACT scores, and AP test scores. KEES
7 Money should also be granted for a percentage of attendance. The money would increase as the student's
8 percentage increases starting at 95%.

10 Section 2: A student that attends 100% of the year would receive \$100.00 of KEES money; a student with
11 99% attendance would receive \$90.00, and so on until a student with a 95% will receive \$50.00.

13 Section 3: The department that is in charge of KEES is the KHEAA (Kentucky Higher Education Assistance
14 Authority).

16 Section 4: Should the bill be passed, it will become effective at the beginning of the school year following its
17 passing. The additional money added to KEES for attendance will come from the Kentucky State Lottery.
