- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 6 Section 1: Anyone over the age of 16 may not speak on a cellphone while behind the wheel of an automobile.

- 8 Section 2: Hands free devices are acceptable as long as the hands belonging to the driver remain on the
- 9 wheel at ten and two (Ex. Bluetooth).

- 11 Section 3: Proper consequences will be determined by the state.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: Citizens should be aware of the upcoming law that will take place in the near future.

- 15 Section 5: Police officers will be trained on how to properly address the situation at hand.
- 16
- 17 Section 6: This law will go into effect in January of 2015.
