1 An act to require that KEES bonuses are given to all Kentucky high school students for passing AP/IB exams.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Currently, students are only eligible for the AP/IB KEES bonuses if they are or have been a part of
6 the Kentucky free or reduced lunch program.

8 Section 2: This bill will require these KEES bonuses to be given to all quallifying Kentucky high shchool
9 students, regardless of their economic standing.

11 Section 3: The funding for this bill will come the KEES money nearly 40% of college students lose after their
12 freshman year isn't being used any longer.

14 Section 4: This bill will go into effect for the upcoming school year after it has been passed.
