1 An act to create a deduction on high school student workers' paycheck as an incentive to work and save
2 money while students are in school.

3
4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: This bill will create a deduction for any student who works while in high school. The deduction will
7 come out of each paycheck at a rate of 2%. The money deducted would be used for public education funds
8 only.

9
10 Section 2: Upon receiving a diploma, students will then file for a refund of the deduction. They will receive all
11 money paid into the fund, plus interest at a rate of 2% higher than the national average interest rate.
12 This deduction would be required of all working students; public, private or home schooled.

14 Section 3: If a student worker does not earn their high school diploma, they will forfeit all earnings paid into
15 the public education deduction fund.

16
17 Section 4: This bill will go into effect during the 2014-2015 school year.
