1 An act to Reduce The Amount of Garbage Produced By Fast-Food Restaurants

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill is to enact a forced placement of a trash can at the end of every fast-food restaurant's
6 drive thru. Being the leading producer of "commercial" garbage and litter, the restaurants must be held
7 accountable. A mutual kinship between restaurants will provide receptacles for each other's garbage.

9 Section 2: This bill is to enforce the removal of garbage from trash cans a minimum of three times a day. The
10 shift intervals will be documented on a check sheet, initialed by the employee and manager to ensure the
11 garbage being removed appropriately. This check sheet will be picked up monthly by the county Health
12 Department, who will also check to ensure the placement of the garbage can.

13
14 Section 3: Any restaurant that does not provide a trash can will be fined \$500 monthly until they comply.

15
16 Section 4: This bill will take effect 60 days after passage.
