1 An act to deny schools the ability to punish any student for a post made outside of their jurisdiction on
2 social media networks.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: This bill will serve as a line to show when schools can get involved in what students post. Involved
7 will be defined as banning them from school activities or events, school teams or clubs, or penalty in class.

9 Section 2: The school can step in if it is within their jurisdiction, such as school hours on school property,
10 school events on and off campus, or field trips. Any other circumstance like school vacations, after school
11 hours, or if they were absent that day may be brought to the attention to the school, but any punishment or
12 consequence must be issued by a law enforcement officer or a parent.

14 Section 3: The bill will be enforced by the county's Board of Education. Any school failing to follow this bill
15 will be appointed to the Kentucky State Board of Education.

17 Section 4: This bill will not cost anything from the school or the student involved, unless law enforcement
18 does get involved- in which case all fees will be personally dealt with under the premise that they do not
19 involve the law itself.

21 Section 5: This bill would go into effect immediately after passage.
