1 An act to add graphic images of the effects of cigarettes on lungs to discourage smoking. 2 3 Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky 4 5 6 Section 1: Currently in the United States, cigarette packaging requirements require tobacco companies to 7 submit an ingredients list of any product sold or imported in the United States. They also require tobacco 8 companies to make public the nicotine content of their products and to adopt standards to reduce or 9 eliminate other harmful substances present. Finally companies must enlarge warnings on tobacco packaging 10 so that they take up 50% of the front and back panel area and regulate the use of terms such as "mild" and 11 "liaht". 12 13 Section 2: It is proposed that New Requirements for cigarette boxes are the following: 1. Font should be 14 printed in easy-to-read with black type on a white background(or vice versa) 2. Black border should surround 15 the message in a way that does not interfere with other information on the box. 3. Each box needs images 16 taking up at least 2/3 of the front of the package clearly showing the damaging effects of smoking. 17

Section 3: The images on the packaging will be paid for by the tobacco companies and regulated by the FDA.

Section 4: Failure from tobacco companies to follow these guidelines will result in the product being pulled
 from the market and the company will be fined 25% of their product sales. This money will be given to cancer
 research or refunded back to the states as part of the tobacco payment plan and used in medicare.
