1 An act to require 50% of fruits and vegetables served during school lunch to be sourced from Kentucky
2 farms.

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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6 Section 1: This bill proposes that all schools in the state of Kentucky are required to serve at least 50% of
7 Kentucky grown fruits and vegetables when in season.

9 Section 2: Money from the national school lunch program, in addition to the money paid out of pocket for
10 lunch, will continue to fund the purchase of fruits and vegetables.
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12 Section 3: This bill will work in partnership with Kentucky Department of Education and United States
13 Department of Agriculture.
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15 Section 4: School districts that fail to abide by this law will result in the following:

16 First offense: A warning will be issued by the Kentucky Department of Education.
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18 Second offense: A \$1,000 fine for each additional documented offense.
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20 Section 5: This bill will be enacted by July 1, 2014.
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
