1	An act to re-instate Public School Nurses
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: In the school year of 2013–2014, the fundings for public school nurses across the state were cut
6	by the Kentucky Department of Health and Resources. Consequently, these cuts created the absence of
7	immediate health care for students in school districts across the state. Moreover, this reduction affects
8 9	schools at every level of education from pre-k thru 12th grade.
10	Section 2: Because of the absence of nurses in most cases, we have found that schools either send the sick
11	student(s) home or send them back to class; thus, affecting the learning process or the causing the potential
12 13	for the spread of illness.
14	Section 3: In the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the state cigarette tax is \$0.60 cents per pack. In the years of
15	2011–2012, citizens of Kentucky generated large tax revenue of \$255 million dollars. Using the information
16	given, we have found that a \$0.13 cent special tax increase on cigarettes would cover all 1,233 public
17	school nurses annual salaries in the state of Kentucky.
18	
19	Section 4: If the school district does not abide by these new laws then the district will be fined \$5,000 and
20	then be forced to hire new nurses for every school in their district.

2122 Section 4: If passed this bill will take effect on August 1, 2014 for all public schools.
