1 An act to allow teachers to carry weapons to school.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Arming teachers is the solution to violent gun crimes at school and will prevent further loss of life
6 if a school is attacked by an armed gunman. The state should enact this bill so no one will have to relive
7 Sandy hook or Columbine in Kentucky schools.

9 Section 2: Teachers will have to pass even further background checks every year and have minimal training
10 with weapons. The teachers will have to have a safe and secure place for the weapon where students and
11 other staff members cannot get to it. There will be only one gun per hallway in a school. Only a few teachers
12 will have a weapon in the school.

14 Section 3: There will be a limited amount of weapons in a school. The teachers cannot tell other teachers
15 were their gun is no matter if they have taken the test or not. Other teachers will not be told who has a gun
16 in the school. The main staff members will be the first to have the test done.

18 Section 4: The teacher can only use the weapon until police have secured the building and then if the weapon
19 was used it will be turned into the police as evidence. The teachers have to be able to identify the target
20 before they fire their weapon.

22 This bill will go into law on June 31, 2014.
