1 2 3	An act to allow terminally ill residents of Kentucky to have the choice to self-administer lethal drugs to end their life.
4 5	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7 8	Section I: Physician assisted suicide allows a physician to prescribe a lethal dose of medication to terminally ill patients so that they may die on their own terms.
9 10 11 12 13	Section II: In order to request the prescription a patient must be 18 years or older and a resident of Kentucky, have been diagnosed with a terminal illness that will lead to death within 1 year by two certified doctors, and have a competent mind when requesting the prescription. Competent will be defined by a certified physician as well as a registered psychiatrist after five hours of in-person evaluation.
14 15 16 17	Section III: To receive a prescription for lethal medication the patient, at a scheduled appointment, must make two or more private, verbal requests to a certified physician separated by at least 15 days. The patient must also provide a written request to his/her physician, signed in the presence of two witnesses.
18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	Section IV: Physicians who would like to participate in physician assisted suicide must publish an annual statistical report including how many prescriptions for lethal medication they filled, how many patients committed physician assisted suicide, and their diagnosis. Additionally, they must take an online course to be properly trained in the requirements and procedures of physician assisted suicide. The course will be created and run by the state. Physicians are also required to inform the patient of feasible alternatives to physician assisted suicide, including comfort care, hospice care, and pain control. The prescribing physician must request, but may not require, the patient to notify his or her next-of-kin of the prescription request.
26 27 28 29 30 31	Section V: In order to fill their prescription and complete physician assisted suicide, the patient and physician schedule a time, date and location. The location must be a private residence or in a medical facility. On the scheduled day, the physician will prepare the medicine after making sure the patient is ready and wants to go through with his or her decision. The patient must independently administer the lethal medication in the presence of their physician.
32 33 34	Section VI: Insurance companies will not be required to offer the choice of physician assisted suicide, however if they do, they must also offer alternate treatment.
35 36 37 38 39	Section VII: In order to create and maintain the online training course, the Health and Welfare Committee of Kentucky will provide an initial cost \$200,000. Following its implementation, doctors will pay a fee of \$500 dollars to take the online course. Every 5 years they must renew their certification for \$200. The fees collected from doctors will cover the ongoing cost of maintaining the course.
40	Section VIII: This bill will go into effect one year after its passing.
