1 An act to prohibit methamphetamine offenders from purchasing psuedoephedrine
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: A database of all methamphetamine offenders will be formulated by the Kentucky State Police and
6 made available to all vendors of products containing pseudoephedrine. Any person whose name is contained
7 in the database will be denied purchase of said product.

9 Section 2: Any methamphetamine offender on the database found in possession of a product containing
10 pseudoephedrine will be issued a \$500 fine.
11
12 Section 3: There will be no additional funding needed for this bill.
13
14 Section 4: This bill will go into effect three months after its passing in order to allot time to create the
15 methamphetamine database.
