1 An act to increase renewable energy retail sales within Kentucky's electrical companies.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: This bill will set a minimum for the amount of electricity an electrical company must sell that is
6 generated from renewable sources, beginning at 1%. The minimum will be raised at a rate of one percent
7 every two years for the next thirty years, or until all companies are obtaining at least 15% of their electricity
8 from renewable sources.

10 Section 2: The Kentucky Public Service Commission will enforce this bill

12 Section 3: Companies that fail to meet the minimum standards in a given year will be fined. Each company
13 will be fined 0.5% of their profits in any given year that they do not meet the requirements.

15 Section 4: The regulations set by this bill will be enforced starting in 2015.
