1	An act to change the KY State Public School Calender Year.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1:This bill will require that all public schools in the state of Kentucky begin their school calendar the
6 7	day after Labor Day and the end their school calendar the day before Memorial Day.
8	Section 2: The purpose of this bill is to allow all public schools in the state of Kentucky to be on the same
9	school calendar. Students would attend classes beginning the day after Labor Day and ending the day
10	before Memorial Day. Schools would still be responsible for setting their own professional development
11	days, holidays, fall and spring breaks, and all other non instructional days. The time of the instructional day
12	will still be based upon school administration preference.
13	
14	Section 3: The Kentcuky Board of Education would need to enforce the implementation of the new school
15 16	calendar. There are several benefits of adopting this new bill. Test scores would not be affected by the change of the school calendar as they have moved the testing windows for all students in the state of
17	Kentucky to the last two full weeks at the end of the semester. Schools also have the opportunity to save
18	money in their budgets, which is a growing concern for many school districts.

20	Section 4: Monetary costs to school systems are minimal. Schools will actually be able to conserve money or
21	invest in 21st Century Learning equipment for their students. This would allow students to participate at a
22	higher level of learning and expand their educational experiences.
