1 An act to require mental health screening as a pre-requisite for driver's license renewal.
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: Presently, in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, there is no act or law to require mental health
6 screening.
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8 Section 2: Mental health screening will help to promote awareness and to provide assistance for those who
9 need it. This will help to prevent mental breakdowns that could cause harm.
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11 Section 3: In Kentucky, drivers are required to renew their license once every four years. This bill would
12 require the process of mental health screening to be completed every other time a driver renews their
13 license.
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15 Section 4: If drivers test to be mentally unstable, they will not be prevented from getting their license, but
16 will be required to receive or provided with assistance for their mental condition. All records for the
17 screening will be kept.
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19 Section 5: This bill will be enacted on January 1st after its passage, and will be funded by the Kentucky
20 Cabinet for Health and Family Services.
