An act to amend the concealed carry law in the state of Kentucky

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: The law currently states anyone the age of 21 or over who isn't a criminal of any type may carry, with a permit from the state of Kentucky, a concealed weapon on their person at any time. The following locations are prohibited for carrying the weapon: police station or sheriff's office, prison or jail, courthouse, government meetings, liquor stores, airports, and schools.

- Section 2: This bill will amend Section 4 of KRS 237.110 to limit the people who can be licensed to carry a concealed weapon. In order to be eligible for a license, this bill will add the requirement that the person must be one of the following:
 - a) employed by a local, sate or federal government
 - b) be current or honorably discharged former military
- c) a law enforcement officer

- Section 3: Currently in Kentucky, a citizen is legally allowed to carry a firearm openly on his or her person.
- This bill does not restrict the right to open carry or own a firearm.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect immediately after passage.
