1 An act to require identification when completing a credit card transaction

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Credit card theft reached an all-time high in 2012 at 3.4 million thefts. Research shows that the
6 number of credit cards stolen will reach 4 million over the next two years.
7
8 Section 2: Not all retail stores currently require you to produce identification (photo id) for a credit or debit
9 card transaction. The state, federal of school issued photo identification will be required by all retail stores
10 when using a credit or debit card for a purchase.

12 Section 3: Offenses will be charged to the owner of the store failing to require identification.
13
14 1st Offense: \$500
15 2nd Offense: \$1000
16 3rd Offense: Loss of store owner's business license
17
18 Section 4: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015
