An act to abolish Affirmative Action in Kentucky
Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
Section 1: Affirmative action refers to policies that take factors including "race, color, religion, gender, sexual
orientation, or national origin" into consideration in order to benefit an underrepresented group "in areas of
employment, education, and business" justified usually as countering the effects of a history of
discrimination. This excludes possible students or workers who are more qualified for the position. This bill
aims to eliminate discrimination so all Kentuckians will be viewed as equal.
Section 2: We propose that any application whether for education or employment have the application
remove any questions related to gender, race, national origin, and sexual orientation.
Section 3: This will be monitored via surveys and surprise inspections of the application process of any
licensed business or state funded college or university. A 3-strike system will be used, 1st strike is a
warning, 2nd strike is a heavy fine, 3rd strike the entity in question can be stripped of its license or state
funding and or possibly closed.
Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1st, 2014.
