1 An act to abolish Affirmative Action in Kentucky

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Affirmative action refers to policies that take factors including "race, color, religion, gender, sexual
6 orientation, or national origin" into consideration in order to benefit an underrepresented group "in areas of
7 employment, education, and business" justified usually as countering the effects of a history of
8 discrimination. This excludes possible students or workers who are more qualified for the position. This bill
9 aims to eliminate discrimination so all Kentuckians will be viewed as equal.

11 Section 2: We propose that any application whether for education or employment have the application
12 remove any questions related to gender, race, national origin, and sexual orientation.

13
14 Section 3: This will be monitored via surveys and surprise inspections of the application process of any
15 licensed business or state funded college or university. A 3-strike system will be used, 1st strike is a
16 warning, 2nd strike is a heavy fine, 3rd strike the entity in question can be stripped of its license or state
17 funding and or possibly closed.

19 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1st, 2014.
