An act to mandate a year round schooling system for the state of Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill, if enacted will require all students of the public school system in the state of Kentucky grades K-12 to attend a year round schooling system model.

Section 2: The state of Kentucky would adopt a "single track" schooling system that would replace the traditional nine-month calendar with a year-round calendar that allows for continuous education with a shorter summer vacation and more frequent breaks during the periods of teaching.

Section 3: The schools would not add any more days than they have in the traditional school year.

Section 4: This school system would not have to incorporate any additional costs when adopting this school calendar; therefore, additional funding would not be required.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2016–2017 school year.
