- 1 An act to establish malpractice standards for veterinarians and animal care clinics

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Medical malpractice laws cover the negligent or incompetent acts of physicians in order to protect
- 6 people from receiving poor care. Currently, medical malpractice does not extend to veterinary doctors. This
- 7 bill would make it possible for the owners farm animals or household pets to be awarded monetary damages
- 8 for negligent or incompetent practices by veterinary doctors or animal care clinics.

- 10 Section 2: Claims of malpractice in Kentucky will be taken to veterinary licensure boards.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: Fees for the investigation of malpractice claims will be covered by veterinary insurance funds.

- 14 Section 4: Enactment of the bill will take place July 1, 2014
