- 1           An act to require an in-depth cardiac screening for all Middle School and High School Athletes.

- 3                           **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5   Section One: The purpose of this bill is to decrease the risk of cardiac arrests within middle school and high
- 6   school athletes.
- 7
- 8   Section Two: All KHSAA or KMSAA afflicted physical forms must require an in-depth cardiac screening. This
- 9   would help decrease the risk of cardiac arrest while the athlete participates in that sport.

- 11   Section Three: Insurance can cover 80 to 100 percent of the screening costs.
- 12
- 13   Section Four: The first offense of failing to ensure an athlete had the screening done would cause the athlete
- 14   to be suspended until ensured the had screening. In second offense, the school would be penalized and fined
- 15   \$150. The fine will increase another \$150 every time the school fails to ensure the athlete has had the
- 16   screening.

- 18   Section Five: This bill will go into effect on August, 1, 2014.
