1 An act to require all Kentucky Public Schools to be more prepared in suicidal and bullying awareness.
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: Every school has to have at least one assembly per semester every year to provide instruction on
6 suicide awareness, on the definition of bullying, and how to prevent it.

8 Section 2: Every school counselor must be trained in first response help to provide assistance to any student
9 with suicidal thoughts. The training will be given every year during the summer in conjunction with other
10 required workshops/trainings.

12 Section 3: Noncompliance will result in following fines:
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14 1st Offense will result in a written warning.
15 2nd Offense will result in a \$1,000 fine.
16 3rd Offense will result in a \$5,000 fine.
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18 All money collected from fines will be utilized in promotion and training materials about bullying and suicide
19 awareness.

21 Section 4: This bill will take effect for the 2015-2016 school year. This will provide schools ample time to
22 train and prepare counselors.
