1 An act to require all schools in Kentucky to have an equal grading scale.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The law states at this moment that each school district has the ability to enforce a grading scale.
6 With that being said, there are many grading scales across the state of Kentucky.

7
8 Section 2: Due to the fact that each school district across the state has a different grading scale the amount
9 of KEES money they receive and the amount of scholarships they can apply for depends on which school
10 they attend.

12 Section 3: This bill would require all school districts to use the same grading scale, the one listed below. This
13 would ensure that all students across the state have an equal and fair opportunity for KEES money and
14 scholarships.

- 15
16 A: 90-100
17 B: 80-89
18 C: 70-79
19 D: 60-69
20 F: 59 and below

21
22 Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this law

23
24 Section 5: School districts that do not comply with this law will be ineligible for students to earn KEES
25 money.

26
27 Section 6: This bill will take effect for the 2014-2015 school year.
