1 An act to increase the price of a Kentucky Cash Ball lottery ticket from \$2 to \$3.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Justification Clause: Annually, thousands of Kentucky college students are denied needs-based grants due to
6 insufficient KHEAA funds.
7
8 Section 1: This bill will provide additional revenue to the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority's
9 needs-based college grants by increasing the price of a Kentucky Cash Ball lottery ticket by \$1.
10
11 Section 2: Needs-based grants are defined as (1) the College Access Program Grant (CAP) and (2) the
12 Kentucky Tuition Grant (KTG). By law, 55% of projected lottery revenue must fund needs-based CAP and
13 KTG grants.

15 Section 3: This will be implemented by the Kentucky Lottery Commission in conjunction with the Kentucky
16 Higher Education Assistance Authority.
17
18 Section 4: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
