1 An act to require Kentucky's public colleges to provide priority course registration for veterans
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: This Act shall be known and may be cited as the Higher Education Course Scheduling Preference
6 for Veteran Students Act.
7
8 Section 2: This Act provides for veteran students to receive a course scheduling preference (priority
9 registration) at public institutions of higher education.
10
11 Section 3: A "veteran" is an individual who has served in the United States Armed Forces, including a Reserve
12 component and National Guard. The veteran must be discharged or released from such service under
13 conditions other than dishonorable.

15 Section 4: A "veteran student" is a veteran, has been admitted to a public institution of higher education, and
16 resides in this Commonwealth while enrolled in the public institution of higher education.

18 Section 5: Within 90 days of the effective date of this section, the Council on Postsecondary Education, in
19 consultation with the public institutions of higher education, shall develop guidelines under which public
20 institutions of higher education shall provide preference in course scheduling to veteran students.

22 Section 6: Within 180 days of the effective date of this section, a public institution of higher education shall
23 be considered in compliance if it provides veteran students with preference in course scheduling pursuant to
24 guidelines developed by the Council on Postsecondary Education.

26 Section 7: This Act shall take effect immediately.
