

1	An act to create a standardized grading scale for all publicly-funded K-12 Kentucky schools
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3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
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5 6	Section 1: All publicly-funded K-12 schools in Kentucky must use the same grading scale.
0 7	Section 2: This policy will go into effect at the beginning of the new school year.

10	EX: 90–100=A, 80–89=B, 70–79=C, 60–69=D, Below 60=F
