1 An act to prohibit the sell of ammunition by any person not holding a valid license to sell firearms.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: This bill is designed to prohibit the sale of ammunition by anyone who does not have a license to
6 sell firearms.
7
8 Section 2: Ammunition sells are not currently monitored after the original sale. In Kentucky, individuals are
9 allowed to purchase ammunition legally and then they often resale that ammunition to persons that could
10 not legally purchase it or for a profit.
11
12 Section 3: This bill will be monitored and enforced by the Kentucky State Police, the ATF and local police
13 agencies.

15 Section 4: Police agencies will monitor high traffic, frequently offending ares and the internet for illegal sales
16 of ammunition.
17
18 Section 5: Consequences for offenders:
19 1st Offense: \$500 fine and 25 hours of community service.
20 2nd Offense: \$1000 fine and maximum of 24 months in jail but no less than 6 months.
21 3rd Offense: \$5000 fine and maximum of 10 years in prison, with a minimum of 4 years.

23 Section 6: This bill will go into effect at 12:01 AM on July 1, 2014.
