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5	Section 1: In order to be college or career ready and productive citizens, students need to be proficient in
6	other world languages.

8	Section 2: All students will have consistent and strategic instruction in a foreign language each year grades
9	K-5. Instruction can be computer based or directly face-to-face. Instruction will be no less than 30 minutes
10	per week.
11	
12	Section 3: Costs could be as little as a computer software program around \$100.00. Some districts may
13	choose to hire a certified, highly qualified teacher.
