1 An act to require Car Rental Companies to service any car that has a recall.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: This bill will require Car Rental Companies to service their vehicles within a 30 day period of
6 receiving a recall notice. Recall vehicles will not be rented out to any individuals until the repair has been
7 fixed.

8
9 Section 2: The Car Rental Company will be required to send in a copy of the repair bill to the Kentucky
10 Department of Transportation. The Kentucky Department of Transportation will monitor and do random
11 checks to see if companies are complying with the law.

12
13 Section 3: Car Rental Companies will not be allowed to rent any vehicle that has not been repaired.

14
15 Section 4: No cost for implementation.

16
17 Section 5: 1st offense: \$100.00
18 2nd offense: \$500.00
19 3rd offense: Recall vehicles will be towed at the expense of the Rental Company
20 with a fine of \$1,000.

21
22 Section 5: This law will go into effect on January 1, 2014.
