1 An act to require all motorcyclists to wear protective head gear.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: All Motorcyclists will be required to wear safety headgear while traveling on all roads and
6 interstates while in the state of Kentucky. If found negligent motorcyclists can be subjected to a fine and/or
7 suspension.

8
9 Section 2: Negligence will be defined as refusal to wear a safety headgear

10
11 Section 3: If a motorcyclist is not wearing a helmet the officer is required to pull the motorcyclists over. The
12 traffic stop must be recorded by the dashboard camera.

13
14 Section 4: First Time Offenders will receive a warning citation
15 Second Time Offenders will receive a \$50 fine
16 Third Time offenders will receive a \$100 fine
17 Fourth Time offenders will receive a \$250 fine and loss of motorcycle license for 3 months
18 Fifth Time offenders will receive \$500 fine and loss of motorcycle license for 6 months

19
20 Section 5: Money raised through fines will go to the transportation department and fund motorcycle safety
21 classes to be taught in driver education courses across the Commonwealth
