1	An act to expand student lunch options so that students have improved choices

3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6	Section 1: Students are wasting school lunch food due to lack of preferred foods.
7 8 9	Section 2: Each school year, students would be surveyed to determine a variety of lunch options to serve in the cafeteria.
10 11	Section 3: A variety of seasonal fruits and vegetables will be included, not just apples and oranges.
12 13 14	Section 4: The survey must be completed by the second Friday of the school year. If it is not completed within the first 30 days of school, a penalty would result.
15 16	Section 5: The penalty would be a fine of \$1.00 per student enrolled at the school.
17 18 19	Section 6: Parents and students could report non-compliant schools to their state representatives. The representatives will visit the school to address the non-compliance.
20 21	Section 7: This bill shall be mandatory for all schools by the 2015–2016 school year. It will be optional, to run on a trial basis, during the 2014–2015 school year.
