Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill will allow teachers/administrators to bear arms for protection of children and faculty.

7 8 9 Section 2: The teachers or administrators who participate in this act will have to go through concealed carry, get a gun license which would be provided by the teacher/administrator, and have an up to date background check (within 4 months). The gun would have to be paid for by the teacher or administrator.

Section 3: The penalty of not going through concealed carry, not having a license, or not having an up to date background check would be:

- No up to date background check- \$250.00
- No license-\$500.00
- No concealed carry -\$800.00

Section 4: All participants would be required to have their gun locked up in a secure place where no one would be able to access it. There would only be 2 keys, one of them for the teacher/administrator and the other for the principal just in case something happened to one of the keys.
