1 An act to make it illegal for children under 10 to be left at home alone overnight.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: Currently there is no law in Kentucky in Regards to Children being left home alone overnight. This  
6 bill would make it illegal to leave children under the age of 10 at home alone or without adult supervision  
7 (anyone over 18) during the overnight hours.

8  
9 Section 2: This bill will help keep children under the age of 10 from becoming victims of abduction,  
10 robberies, and accidents.

12 Section 3: Penalties for not following this law:

- 1st Offense: Referral to Social Sevices
  - 15 • 2nd Offense: 250.00 fine plus assigned a social worker who makes regular visits to the home.
  - 16 • 3rd Offense: Child/Children removed from the home and Charges for abandonment, neglect, and  
17 Wanton endangerment will be filled with the Police department.

18  
19 Section 4: This bill will be monitored and enforced by social services, police departments and School  
20 authorities.

22 Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2014
