1 An act to require all motorcycle riders, regardless of age, to wear helmets when riding on the highway.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to reduce head injuries in motorcycle accidents.

7 Section 2: This bill will not cost any money from the people. It will save citizens' lives.

9 Section 3: State, city and county police officers will enforce this law.

11 Section 4: Offenders that fail to meet the requirements of this bill will be subjected to the following penalties:

13 • 1st Offense - \$25.00 fine
14 • 2nd Offense - \$50.00 fine
15 • 3rd Offense - \$75.00 fine and suspend license for 30 days.
16 • 4th Offense - \$150.00 fine and suspend license for 60 days.

18 Section 5: This bill shall go in effect 90 days after passing.
