

1 2 3	An act to require all high school students to perform ten hours of community service each year of high school.
4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7 8 9	Section 1: This act applies to all high school students of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. This act requires all high school students to perform ten hours of community service each year enrolled in a Kentucky high school for a total of 40 hours.
10 11 12	Section 2: The bill will be of no cost to the state and school. The monitoring will be through the students individual learning plan (ILP) which students are already required to complete yearly.
13 14 15 16	Section 3: If the student does not complete the required amount of community service, the student's penalty will consist of being unable to graduate. Some students may be excluded from the requirement based on special needs.
17 18 19 20	Section 4: This act will be in effect for the students entering high school in 2016; graduating class of 2020. Students entering Kentucky schools from other states will be required to complete 10 hours per year completed in a Kentucky school.
