

1 An act to to require mandatory rehabilitation for convicted opiate pharmaceutical abusers 2 3 Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky 4 5 6 7 8 Section 1: People convicted of first time drug offense for abusing opiates or pharmaceuticals will be required to go to a drug rehabilitation clinic for one month. Drug abusers who have bee arrested two or more times will be required to go to a rehabilitation clinic for six months. 9 Section 2: Payment for rehabilitation will come from a variety of sources. Bail money from convicted drug 10 abusers will go toward rehabilitation costs. This will be combined with insurance and out of pocket cost. 11 Those who are below the poverty line will utilize free rehabilitation centers and work out payment methods. 12 13 Section 3: If rehabilitation centers are full, convicted drug abusers will spend their time in jail until vacancies 14 are available. This time will be deducted from their total mandated rehabilitation. 15 16 Section 4: Addicts who do not comply with this bill will serve additional mandated time in jail. 17 18 Section 5: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2015.
