1 An act to require lottery industries to keep their winners' identities secret in Kentucky.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: All lottery winners will not have their personal information given out by media in the
6 Commonwealth of Kentucky.
7
8 Section 2: All lottery industries in the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall abide by this law. (Mega-Millions,
9 Powerball, Pick 4, Pick 3, Draw Games, and Promotions).

11 Section 3: Even though the lottery industries cannot expose their names the winners may reveal their
12 identities to the media if wanted.
13
14 Section 4: This bill will have no cost.
15
16 Section 5: This bill will be enforced by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

18 Section 6: Lottery Industries that fail to abide by this law will be punished as following:
19
20 1st Offence: The person or group of people who leaked the information will be terminated.
21
22 Section 7: All laws or parts or laws that conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

24 Section 8: This bill will go into effect ninety (90) days after passage and signature by the Governor.
