1 An act to terminate child custody disputes after one year, unless in an abusive home.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: All custody disputes need to be settled within one (1) year of a divorce unless placed in an  
6 accused abusers home in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

7  
8 Section 2: Any couple who has children and files for a divorce in the Commonwealth of Kentucky must abide  
9 by this law.

10  
11 Section 3: Child custody is when parents have the rights to make decisions for their child/children and the  
12 parents duty to care for the child.

13  
14 Section 4: This bill will have no cost.

15  
16 Section 5: This bill will be enforced by the judge of the family and of the child custody battle dispute.

17  
18 Section 6: Child Custody rights that fail to abide by this law will be punished as follows:

19  
20 1st Offence: A verbal warning by the Judge that the court case will have to be settled within one month

21 2nd Offence: A one-thousand (\$1000) fine for each parent after two (2) months.

22 3rd Offence: The child will go into foster care after three (3) months until the case is finalized.

23  
24 Section 7: All laws or parts of the laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

25  
26 Section 8: This will go into effect one-hundred and eighty (180) days after passage and signature by the  
27 governor.
