1 An act requiring business establishments having public restrooms to have baby changing stations accessible
2 to men and women.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5
6 **Section 1: Business Requirements**

7 The stations must be in both men's and women's restrooms, or in unisex restrooms. The baby changing
8 station must attach to a wall, a table, a countertop or other suitable surface. Signs must be visible showing
9 where the stations are located.

10
11 **Section 2: Business Types Required**

12 Any establishment that has a public restroom; whether they have a separate Men's and Women's Restroom
13 or a unisex restroom.

14
15 **Section 3: Penalty**

16 Failure to comply with this proposed law would result in a \$500 fine for the first offense. \$750 for second
17 offense. \$1,000.00 for every offense thereafter. Establishments have fifteen (15) days after being fined to
18 take corrective action before facing another penalty.

19
20 **Section 4: Effective Date**

21 This bill will go into effect one (1) year after it is passed.
